



# Open Up Lamp - Instructions





**1** Remove the light bulb, unscrew light fitting, place the clamp in place, and then replace the light fitting and bulb. Make sure that any lugs on the light fitting do not line up with the slots in the clamp.

**2** Now prepare the petals. There is a shiny side and a textured side. The textured side should be the outer surface once the lamp has been made up. Fold each petal along the centreline as shown. It is important that petals are folded to the same extent, so that the lamp looks symmetrical when assembled. Fold the tab so it points out at 90 degrees. There are three petals with rounded ends (outer petals) and three with pointed ends (inner petals).




**3** **Inner Strip** Locate the three metal strips that do not have the tops bent back on themselves (picture).  
**Outer Strip** These go with the inner (pointed) petals.

**4** Pair up the three inner strips with the pointed inner petals, and the three outer strips with the outer (rounded) petals. Bend the tip of each petal and thread the bottom of the accompanying strip through as shown on the right.



**5** Look at the clamp & you'll notice that there are three nodules on the circumference. They mark the slots for the inner strips. Squeeze the top section of the inner strip and push it through the innermost slot in the clamp until it is located as shown. Repeat for the other two inner strips.

**6** Next take the top of each of the inner petals and push them up through the corresponding outermost slot on the clamp. Repeat this for each of the inner petals. Repeat steps 5 & 6 for the outer strips/petals.



**7** You have now assembled your Open Up Lamp. If you switch on the light, in approx 5 mins it should have opened up to resemble the picture on the front.
